Election Manifesto 2026

Miljöpartiet is standing in the elections for a fair climate transition all over the country, a more equal society that strengthens Sweden and stronger protection for nature and the environment. We stand for democracy, for human rights and for the freedom and rights of all people to shape their own lives.

Sweden benefits from...

- 1. Reducing our emissions** and being a strong voice for high climate ambitions, both in the EU and internationally.
- 2. Focusing strongly on climate investments** such as the railways, renewable electricity and green industry to create a host of new jobs.
- 3. Ending its dependence on fossil fuels** and expanding renewable energy. Give local communities their share of the profits from wind and hydro power.
- 4. Introducing a national pass for public transport** that is valid throughout the country – SEK 499 for adults and SEK 249 for children, students and pensioners.
- 5. Rolling out a national electric vehicle offensive:** everyone must be able to afford the switch to an electric vehicle.
- 6. Reducing economic inequality** by taxing the super-rich and increasing the housing allowance and child benefit, and introducing a special supplement for single parents.
- 7. Abolishing the market-based school system, stopping profits and putting an end to school segregation.** School should be more equal, with more resources and smaller groups of children in the classroom.
- 8. Cutting the queues in the healthcare system, improving the working conditions of healthcare staff** and expanding primary care to make it easily accessible to all.
- 9. Making sure that more people receive prompt help with their mental health, and identifying children and young people in time.**
- 10. Reducing the working hours for all** and taking the first steps towards a four-day week.
- 11. Abolishing the sick pay deduction** and giving greater peace of mind in the event of illness.
- 12. Protecting more valuable nature** and maintaining strong coastal protection.
- 13. Stopping industrial trawlers and overfishing,** and supporting coastal fishing.
- 14. Improving animal welfare.** Less crowding and more outdoor access for animals, and an end to fast-growing chickens and painful animal experiments.
- 15. Catching more criminal gang members,** boosting preventive work and increasing the local police presence.
- 16. Increasing gender equality.** Women must feel safe, have the same economic empowerment and receive healthcare on the same conditions as men.
- 17. Boosting the protection of our drinking water** and investing more in climate adaptation.
- 18. Improving contingency preparedness for our food supply chain** and strengthening Swedish agriculture.
- 19. Increasing support for culture,** with an extra SEK 1 billion for civil society and the introduction of a cultural right of public access for all children.
- 20. Stopping unreasonable expulsions:** no more expulsions of teenagers or separation of families. People who have made their lives in Sweden must be allowed to stay.
- 21. Improving family policies for rainbow families.** Defend and strengthen the rights of LGBTIQ individuals.
- 22. Building a strong total defence,** increasing Swedish aid and defending international law.
